COMPETITION RULES

- This is a Routine competition. There are no Figures.
- Events: Solos (Free, Tech, Male, Female), Duets (Free, Tech, Mixed Free, Mixed Tech), Trios, Teams (Free), Combo.
- ❖ Age Groups: 10&U, 12&U, Youth, Junior, Senior, Masters.
- There will be a Novice competition. Novice Age Groups: 10&U, 12&U, Youth, Junior, Senior, Masters.
- ❖ Age of the competitor is as at 31 December 2024.

❖ Solos:

- Clubs may enter a maximum of 2 Solos per event.
- Clubs wishing to enter more than 2 solos per event may request the additional entries. These will be considered and is dependent on whether competition time allows.
- A competitor may enter 1 Free Solo event and 1 Tech Solo event (where Tech Solo is available) only. E.g. In the case of a 15-year-old, the athlete must choose between entering either Youth, or Junior, or Senior; per event. In this example: the athlete could enter Youth Free Solo and Junior Tech Solo.

Duets:

There is no limit to the number of Duet and Mixed Duet entries.



- Team Routines and Combos:
 - Clubs may include competitors from all events and all Age Groups, including Novice athletes.
 - o Team event: minimum 4 swimmers, maximum 8 swimmers.
 - o Combo event: minimum 4 swimmers, maximum 10 swimmers.
 - o There will be one competition for Team Routines, incorporating all Age Groups.
 - There will be one competition for Combo, incorporating all Age Groups.
 - If entries are received where it is justified to divide the entries into Age Group categories, this will be considered and implemented at the discretion of the organisers.
 - A separate competition will be considered for Novice Teams and Novice Combos, for those entries which consist of only Novice athletes.
- ❖ Athletes from different Age Groups may compete together. The competitors would be entered in the event of the oldest Age Group of the athletes concerned. E.g. a 12U and Junior athlete may swim a Duet together, entered under the Junior Duet event.
- Male athletes are included in all events.
- The routine time limits are specified below.
- Judging:
 - Novice, Masters, Trios, Teams, Combos, 10&U and 12&U events: Routines will be judged according to the "Old Rules" FINA Rules 2017 – 2021 (Free choreography).
 - Youth, Junior and Senior Age Group events will be judged according to the "New Rules" World Aquatics Rules 2022 – 2025 (Declared Difficulty Coaches Cards).
 - Should an athlete wish to enter an event and be judged according to Old or New Rules which is not catered for above, please let us know and we will do our best to accommodate the entry. E.g. a 12U Soloist wanting to be judged according to the "New Rules".
- Swimmer substitutions to be submitted to the LOC in writing a minimum of 24 hours ahead of the event.
- ❖ There are no preliminary events; all events are considered Finals.
- ❖ The start list draw will be done at the first Managers' meeting.
- Clubs to please supply a Judge and/or a Technical Controller which is much appreciated.
- ❖ The organising committee retains the right to change or amend the rules of the competition after entries are received. Any changes will be notified timeously.
- The LOC are open to requests from clubs to accommodate any special requests.

- Combo
- Masters

The following Solo and Duet events will be Judged under the new WA rules 2022 – 2025:

- Youth
- Junior
- Senior

Should an athlete wish to enter a routine and be judged differently to the above, please do request this from the organisers and we will endeavour to accommodate your request.

MEDALS AND AWARDS

- ❖ Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all events.
- ❖ Ribbons will be awarded for 4th and 5th places.
- ❖ Each other competitor will receive a participation medal.



BOOKINGS PROCESS AND ENTRY FEES

Bookings will open on 1st July.

We are delighted to partner with PureTravel who will manage all your bookings for you. PureTravel are experienced operators who manage logistic and bookings for World Cup events.

This includes Hotel Accommodation and meals; Competition Entry Fees, Airflight bookings and Airport transfers and optional Tour Packages. All payments are made direct to Pure Travel through their booking website including Entry Fees.

Entry Fees:

ZAR1600 (approx. USD85) per athlete – unlimited events

Accommodation:

- Double room shared: ZAR1900 (Approx USD100) per person per night - including Breakfast and Dinner; practice and competition day transport (25/26/27); Awards Dinner function.
- Single room: ZAR2700 (Approx USD140) per person per night - including Breakfast and Dinner; practice and competition day transport (25/26/27): Awards Dinner function.

Flights:

- Pure Travel will arrange your flight and transfer bookings for you at the best possible rates. While this is optional, it is recommended to make use of this service as PureTravel will manage all logistics and flight booking requirements for you.
- All Airport transfers will be included in the PureTravel flight cost.
- There will be an additional Airport Transfer cost should you elect to use your own booking agent. Transfers can be booked separately with PureTravel. The sooner you book the cheaper flights are likely to be.

Process:

Note your basic requirements on the website link and a booking agent will get back to you with a booking form to understand your exact requirements. Once these are understood you will be able to book and pay directly on the website. PureTravel will manage every aspect of your booking and will be able to adjust and modify your bookings as required. Bookings open on July 1st.

SWIMMING POOLS

Kingsmead College Aquatics Centre, 132 Oxford Rd, entrance in Tottenham Ave, Rosebank, Johannesburg.



Competition pool 25m x 20m x 2m deep

Pool temperature: 27°C

Warmup pool 25m x 18m x 1.2m deep, plus diving well

Pool temperature: 29°C

BASE CAMP - GYMNASIUM

Each Club will be allocated a space indoors for storing bags etc. The space will also be available for athletes to prepare hair and makeup and do their land warm up.

The Gymnasium is located near the warmup pool.

THE CITY OF JOHANNESBURG TOURISM

Don't rush back home after the competition ... there is plenty to see in Johannesburg! Here are just a few suggestions of things to do after the competition. We will send more information on these closer to the time!

Lesedi Cultural Village

Village Tour, African drumming for all to participate, dance show, traditional Buffet Lunch or Dinner with Marimba serenade.

Lion & Safari Park

View zebras, wildebeest, impala, blesbok, warthogs etc in the veld, plus the 4 vast enclosures with lions, cheetahs & wild dogs. Feed the one/two tame giraffes.

City sightseeing bus

Hop on our Johannesburg Red Tour at our main departure point in Rosebank and explore the leafy suburbs of Joburg, stopping at all the top attractions along the way, including Melrose Arch and Mandela Foundation before reaching Constitution Hill. From here the Red Tour continues via the inner city to the Mining District, Apartheid Museum and Gold Reef City Theme Park. The next stops are at Newtown, The Playground, Johannesburg Zoo and the Military Museum before heading back to Rosebank. You'll soon see why Joburg is not only considered Africa's economic playground but also one of the most wooded cities in the world.
