SA NATIONAL AQUATIC CHAMPIONSHIPS 2023

1. GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

- 1.1. The 2023 Swimming South Africa National Artistic Swimming Championships will take place at Reddam School, Constantia from 3rd to 6 April 2023. Training day 3 April (TBC depending on judges' course)
- 1.2. The TASC will circulate the program once SSA receive final entries.
- 1.3. This competition will serve as final team selection for World Aquatics (FINA) Youth, and Senior Championships 2023 and any competitions up to June 2024. All athletes wishing to be considered for these teams must attend in person either Nationals (affiliate based) or Level 3 (club based).
- 1.4. This competition will serve as final solo, duet selection for World Aquatics Youth, and Senior Championships 2023. All athletes wishing to be considered for these events must attend in person either Nationals (affiliate based) or Level 3 (club based).
- 1.5. The SSA National Championships consists of Senior Nationals (15+), Junior Nationals (15-19) and Youth Nationals (13-15).

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- 2.1 All Affiliates with SSA registered members, are invited to compete at the event
- 2.2 Selection is at the discretion of the affiliate selection committee.
- 2.3 Athletes entered in Senior Nationals should be 15 or older on 31 December 2023 and should ideally have previously achieved an overall score of 50.00 or above at SSA Level 3 or NAG.
- 2.4 Athletes entered in Junior Nationals should be 15, 16, 17, 18 or 19 of years on 31 December 2023 and should ideally have previously achieved an overall score of 50.00 or above at SSA Level 3 or NAG.
- 2.5 Athletes entered in Youth Nationals should be aged 13, 14 or 15 on 31 December 2023 and should ideally have previously achieved an overall score of 50.00 at either SSA Level 3 or NAG.
- 2.6 Competitors may **not** enter Youth, Junior and Senior Nationals **in the same event**.
- 2.7 Once a competitor has competed at Youth, Junior or Senior Nationals they may not compete at Level 3 again.



- 2.8 Swimmers from Youth Nationals (aged 15 years for routines on 31 December 2023) and Junior Nationals may compete in the Senior teams and Acrobatic routines.
- 2.9 By competing in these Senior team events, swimmers will not lose their eligibility to compete at Youth Nationals or Junior Nationals
- 2.10 Entries must be made on a spreadsheet. Entries must include affiliate, name of athlete, SSA registration number and events entered. Please mark reserves where applicable.

Entry Fees for: Figures, Free Solos, Tech Solos R200.00 per entry

Free Duets, Tech Duets R300.00 per entry (R150 per swimmer)

Teams (Tech, Free, Combo, acrobatic) R400.00 per each team.

2.12 Team Managers must bring a copy of proof of payment and the entries to the SA National Championships management meeting.

2. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- 3.1 Only technical officials registered with SSA will be eligible to officiate.
- 3.2 Each affiliate entering must supply at least 2 registered officials (judge and/or technical officials). The host affiliate will make up any shortfall.
- 3.3 The Technical Committee will source any additional external judges required to make up any judging shortfall.
- 3.4 Technical Officials must be correctly attired, navy-blue skirts/trousers, white shoes and white shirt.



3. **COMPETITION RULES**

- 4.1 These competitions run according to the following rules laid out in the SSA Technical Guidelines. **World Aquatics (FINA) rules take preference** unless otherwise stated. (Please consult the Artistic Swimming Rules 2022-2025 and all associated appendices for more information, all documentation available at www.fina.org/artistic-swimming/rules).
- 4.2 Competitors, coaches, managers and officials must be capitated to SSA through their affiliate.
- 4.3 Competitors, coaches, managers and officials should be dressed in official affiliate kit, or unbranded attire, no club or other branded kit.
- 4.4 The Senior competition comprises Solo Free (Male & Female), Solo Technical (Male & Female), Duet free, Duet technical, Mixed Duet (Free and Technical), Team Free, Team Technical, Acrobatic Routine, Technical and free routines comprise separate events with separate medals awarded.
- 4.5 The Junior competition comprises, Solo Free (Male & Female), Solo Technical (Male & Female), Duet free, Duet technical, Mixed duet (Free and Technical), Team Free, Team Technical, Technical and free routines comprise separate events with separate medals awarded.
- 4.6 The Youth age group comprises World Aquatics (FINA) (13-15) figures (Appendix I), Solo Free (Male & Female), Duet Free, Mixed Duet Free, Free Team and Free Routine Combination.
- 4.7 World Aquatics (FINA) Figure groups apply for Youth Nationals (See Appendix I). A draw will take place 72 hours prior to the competition according to World Aquatics (FINA) rules. Athletes will compete in all 4 figures.
- 4.8 An event summary is listed below:

- 4.9 Affiliates with 4 or more swimmers aged 15 years or older competing in Junior or Senior Nationals must enter senior technical or free team events (depending on ages).
- 4.10 A team consists of 4 to 8 swimmers. The FINA penalty for a team comprising less than 8 swimmers will be applied.
- 4.11 A Free Combination has a minimum of 4 swimmers, maximum of 10 (See Appendix V).
- 4.12 An Acrobatic routine has a minimum of 8 swimmers, maximum of 10 (See Appendix IV and VII).
- 4.13 All routine time limits and required number of hybrids for all events are listed in Appendix III.
- 4.14 A minimum overall score of 50.00 must be achieved to qualify for medals.



- 4.15 Athletes from different affiliates may compete together in teams and duets. Points are allocated on a pro rata basis.
- 4.16 A completed Coaches Cards (template Appendix VIII) must be submitted for each routine, one week prior to the competition. (see Appendix VI and Appendix VI Addendum for guidance on completing the Coaches Card).
- 4.17 For each technical routine, the selected A or B option per element as well as the order in which the elements will be swum must be submitted in writing to the organizers one week prior to the competition (see Appendix II for all technical elements).

5 TROPHIES – Senior Nationals

- 5.1 Winning affiliate member (points allocated per SSA points table)
- 5.2 Winning team (combined technical and free score)
- 5.3 Winning duet (combined technical and free score)
- 5.4 Winning solo (combined technical and free score)
- 5.5 Highest scoring routine
- 5.6 The most improved Artistic Swimmer. (The most improved artistic swimmer is determined by taking the scores from the previous year's free solo and calculating the improvement against the current year's free solo.)
- 5.7 Please ensure all trophies awarded in 2022 are returned at the Managers' meeting.
